Scholarship Information:

This scholarship is to assist in covering costs related to attending the SNA Future Leaders Conference scheduled for April 27-29 in Louisville, KY. By applying for this scholarship you acknowledge that you plan on attending the FSNA Future Leaders Conference if you are awarded the scholarship.

Scholarship recipients will be required to complete and submit the FSNA Future Leaders Application. The scholarship will include the registration fee, lodging, transportation costs, and meals.

Criteria for Selection - Individuals applying for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Be an SNA **and** FSNA member
- Hold an SNA Certificate in School Nutrition and/or hold the SNS Credential
- Minimum of 3 years in school nutrition
- Demonstrated qualities for future association leadership and shown evidence of strong leadership potential
- Demonstrated interest in developing leadership abilities and shaping the next generation of state association/SNA initiatives
- Committed to life-long learning and career in school nutrition
- Energetic individual who believes in the importance of their local/state association and who is most likely to contribute to long-term growth and development
- Can be an FSNA Board member, but should not have served as state president or currently serving as state president-elect or president.

Please write an essay of no more than 800 words. Essays will be judged on the following, so please address as many of these areas as possible:

Applicant expresses that he/she:

- Has qualities for future association leadership.
- Has strong leadership potential.
- Has an interest in developing leadership abilities.
- Expresses interest in shaping the next generation of FSNA/SNA initiatives.
- Is committed to lifelong learning.
- Is committed to their career in school nutrition.
- Believes in the importance of their local association.
- Believes in the importance of the state association.
- Will contribute to the growth & development of FSNA & their local association.

The maximum number of words for the essay is 800 and will be strictly enforced. Essays of more than 800 words will be disqualified.

Timeline:

- Scholarship Applications with the 800 word essay will be due back to FSNA by January 31, 2023
- Applications will be processed by FSNA and sent to the Chair of the Past President's & Silver Circle Advisory Board to be judged by members of the FSNA Past Presidents & Silver Circle Advisory Council.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by February 1, 2023.
