



Florida School Nutrition Association President's Award

All FSNA Award Submissions are due May 15

All local chapters may apply for the Florida School Nutrition Association President's Award. The award is based around the completion of the State Plan of Action for the Year. One Initiative for the Objective must be completed from each of the four Goals. The Award is divided into three levels:

- **Gold Award** – Completion of 10 initiatives. With slide documentation (pictures, videos) supporting the completion of each and all of the initiatives.
- **Silver Award** – Completion of 8 initiatives. With slide documentation (pictures, videos) supporting the completion of the initiatives.
- **Bronze Award** – Completion of 6 initiatives. With slide documentation (pictures, videos) supporting the completion of the initiatives.

How to Apply

At the FSNA Annual Conference & Expo, the President's Gold, Silver, and Bronze medallions will be presented to those Chapter Presidents who meet the required criteria and submit the following information:

1. The completed Chapter Presidents Tracking Sheet outlining the Initiatives completed under each Goal.
2. A Power Point presentation which:
 - Includes a title page slide with your name, e-mail, school, county and region. This information will be used for certificates, presentation and other award information so be precise.
 - Tells the Goal, Objective and the Initiatives completed.
 - Provides photos and/or videos (2 minutes or less) that explain what was done to support each Goal.
 - Total length of the presentation doesn't exceed 15 slides and slide transitions should be set at the appropriate speed to be able to understand what is being presented.
 - One or two slides at the end of the presentation that summarizes the major activities and outstanding accomplishments during the president's term in office.

Submission Instructions

All submissions should be submitted to awards@floridaschoolnutrition.org by **April 15**. Submissions received after April 15 will not be considered.

Award of Excellence

The President's Award of Excellence will also be awarded and shown at the FSNA Annual Conference & Expo. Each year, this award will recognize one chapter president who demonstrated extraordinary leadership during their year as president. This will be determined from all the President's Gold Award winners.

Judging & Special Instructions

Judging will be done by the FSNA President and President-Elect. Only Power Point presentations will be considered. All presentations, including photos and videos may be shown at any FSNA event.
